Shovels

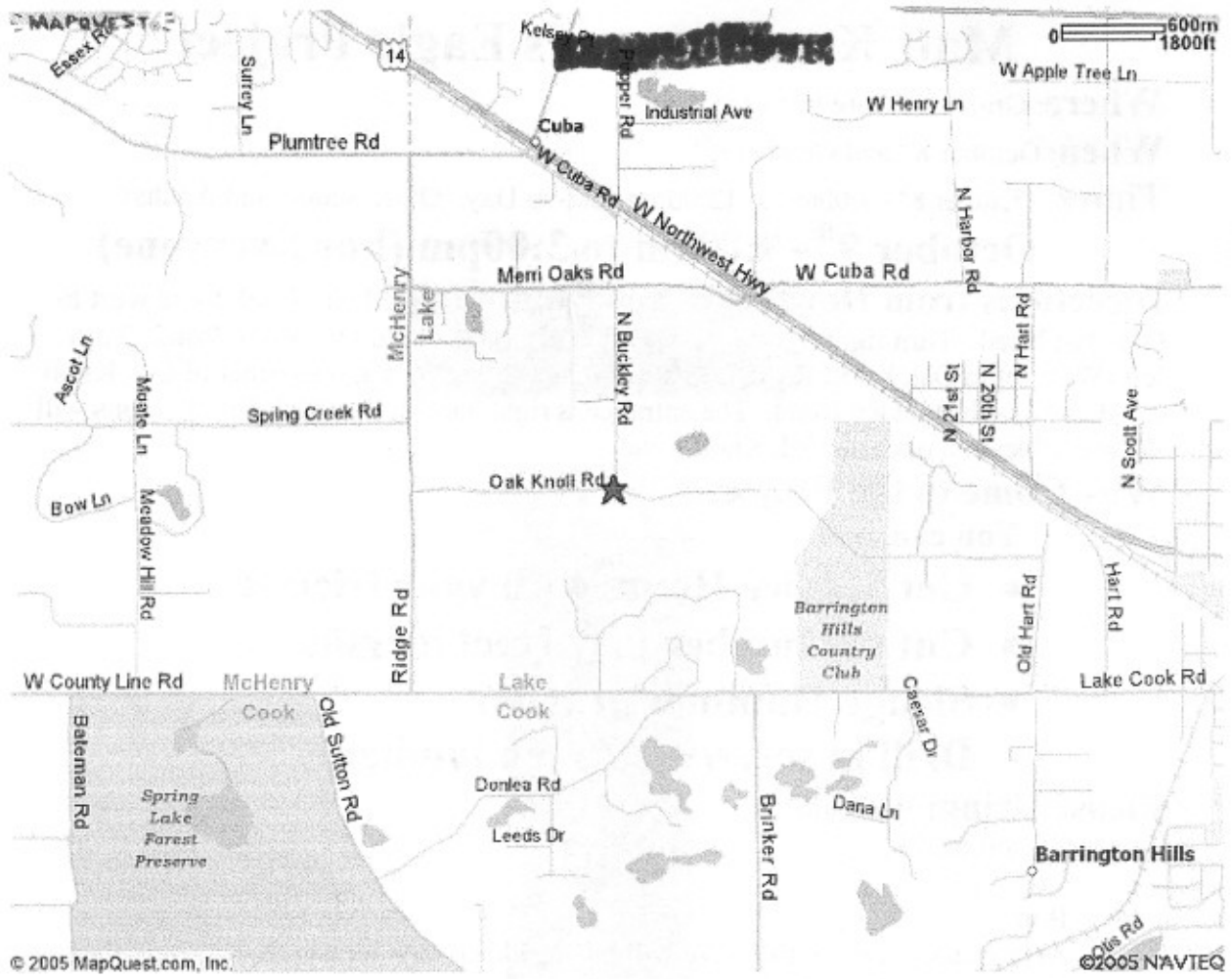
