### **Physicals are required for Camp Napowan**

#### **Scouts:**

All Scouts who wish to attend camp require a physical examination within the 12 months prior to attending camp. Parts A, B, and C of the BSA health form must be completed.

#### **Adults:**

Adults staying at camp more than 72 hours required to have a physical within 12 months prior to camp. Parts A and B for less than 72 hours. Parts A, B, and C for more than 72 hours.
